PATH PATROL DUTIES



First on the Water (novice weekdays, varsity Saturdays)

- 1. **Put out "Caution. Slow. Boat Xing Ahead" signs**. Signs are located in boathouse, near the overhead door closest to the water. Signs are placed in sign holders in the ground and can be found by the small red dot markings along the edge of the towpath approximately 45-55 paces to the right and the left of the boathouse.
- 2. **Unlock bathrooms**. The key is hanging on a hook behind the door (off of the porch). The keychain is an oar. Please return key to same location.

General Duties:

- 1. **Path Patrol** At the beginning and end of practice, when boats are being carried across the towpath, help with the traffic on the path. The path traffic (walkers, bike riders, etc.) has the right of way. Boats need to wait until it is safe to cross.
- 2. **Presence at the Boathouse** Answer any incoming phone calls. Place any written messages in the appropriate coach's box. (Coaches' mail slots are located next to the workbench in the back of the boathouse). Also, make sure no one enters the boathouse or disturbs Crew belongings, including rowers' shoes, etc. on the dock.
- 3. **Supervise** any rowers not on the water.
- 4. Perform general cleanup duties around the boathouse
 - a. Wash dishes in the sink
 - b. Sweep floor if needed
 - c. Straighten up lost and found/towels if needed
 - d. General cleanup of the boathouse space or perimeter

At End of Practice:

- 1. **Remove the signs** and put them back in boathouse, near the overhead door closest to the water.
- 2. **Lock the bathroom doors**. Be sure to turn off the lights and return the key to its location.
